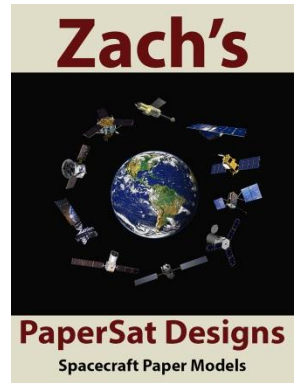


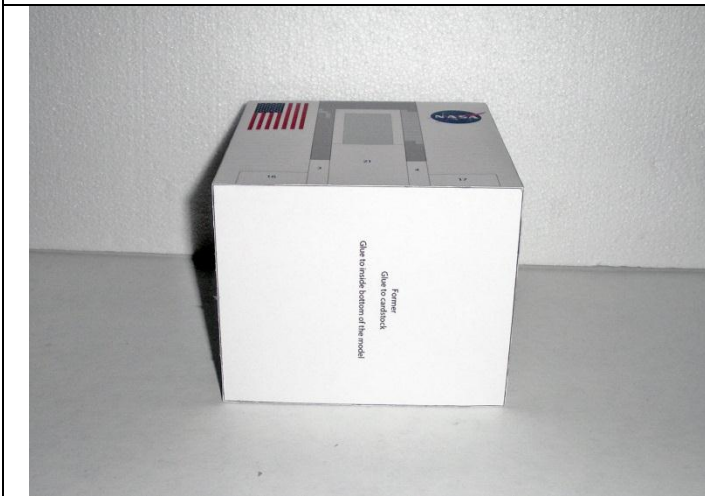
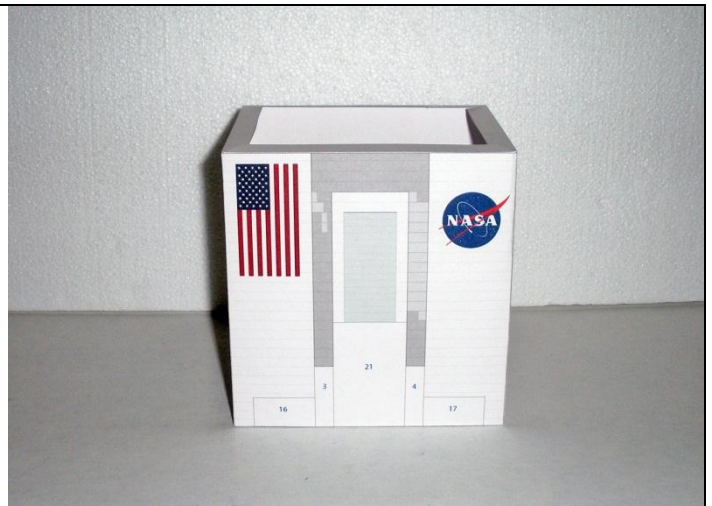
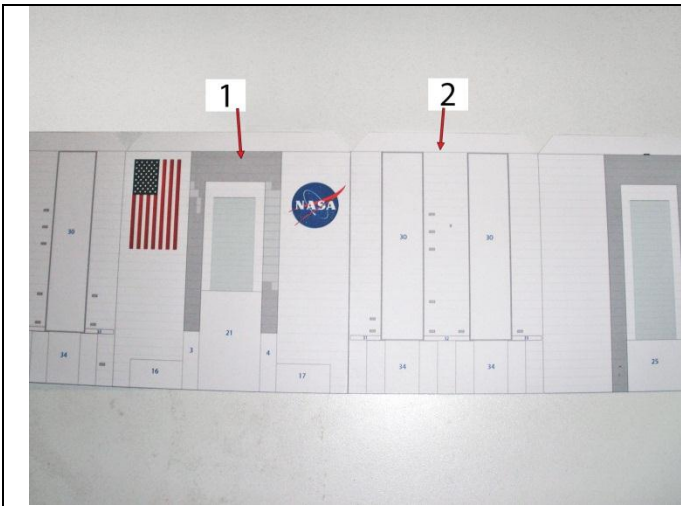
KSC vehicle assembly building - Artemis 1/1310 Scale Paper Model Instructions



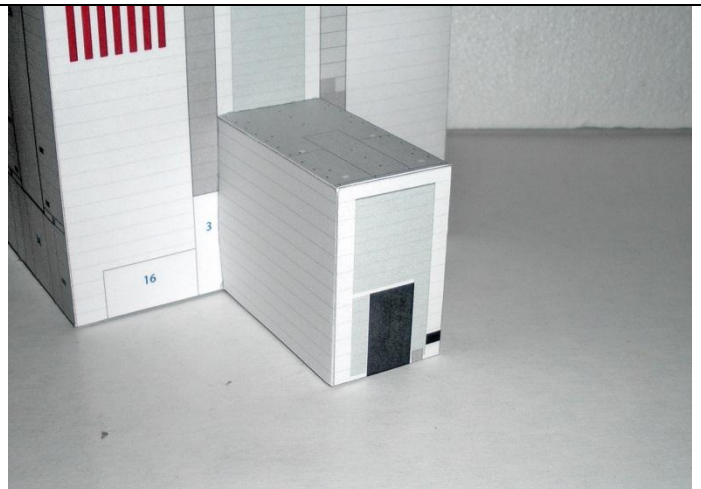
KSC vehicle assembly building with the Artemis logo

NOTE: This is a well-detailed model consisting many parts that need to be glued on multiple layers of cardstock and a number of small parts. Please follow the pre-assembly instructions for these parts on the parts file. This is also my first design of a stucture or building.

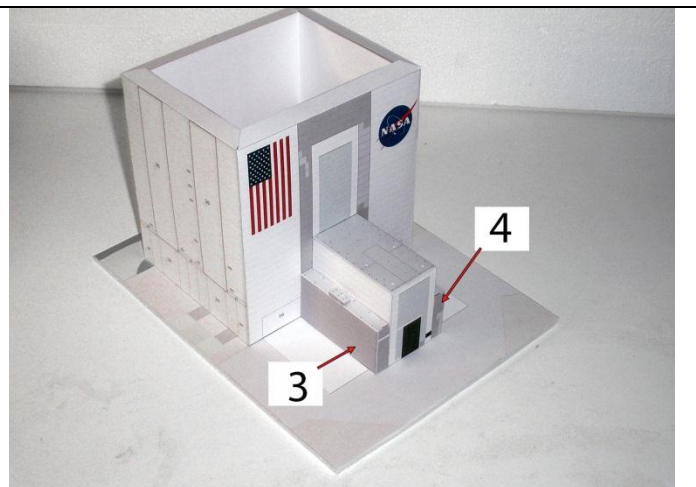
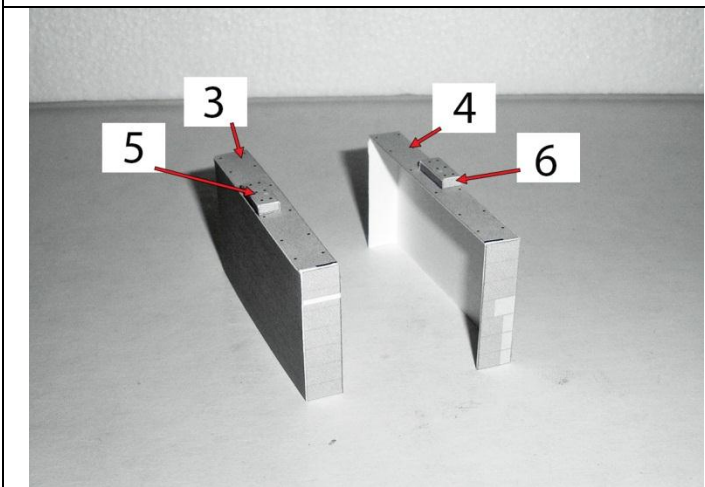
Best if printed 110lb cardstock.

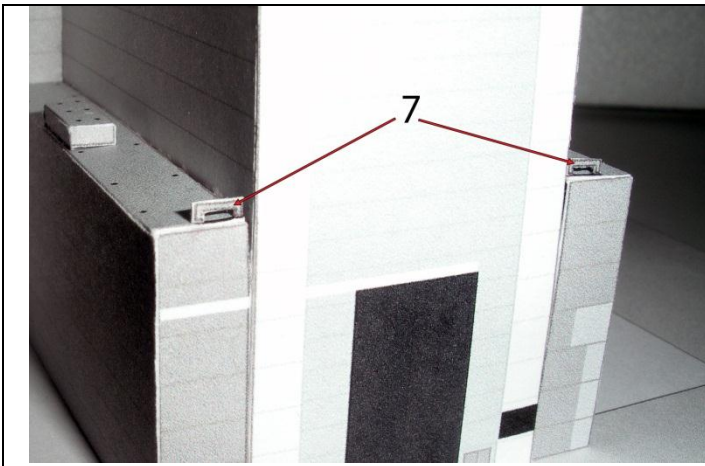


Glue to inside bottom

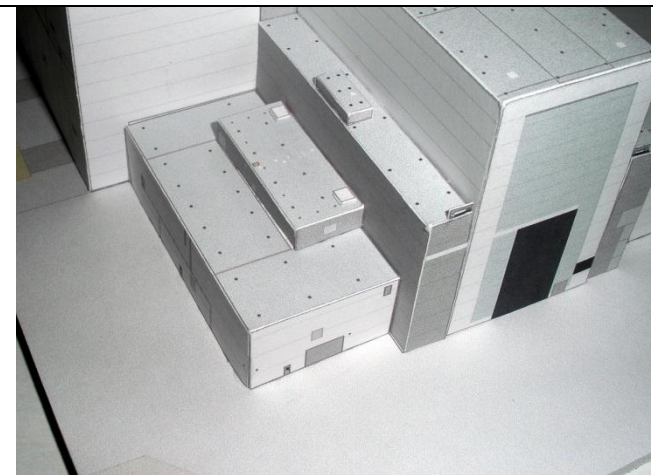
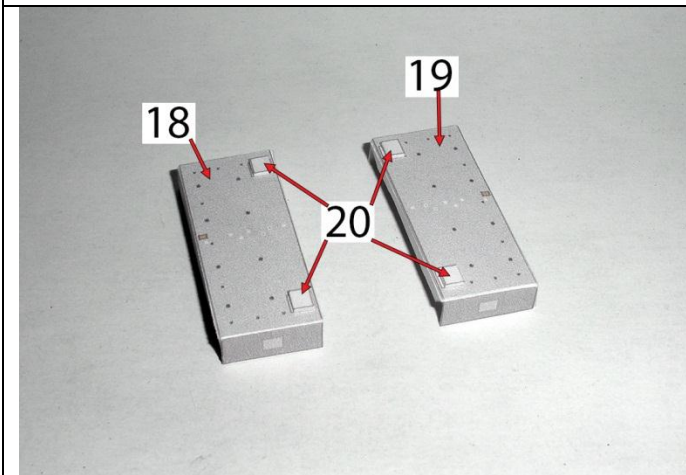
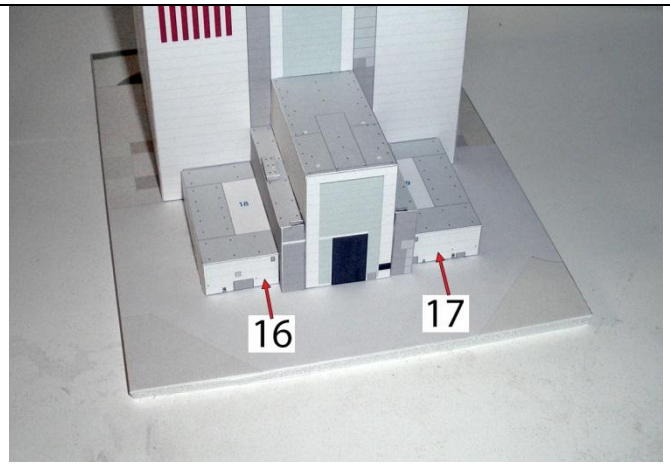


Can glue to the base provided on page 8 on the parts file, this will help keep the model straight during assembly.

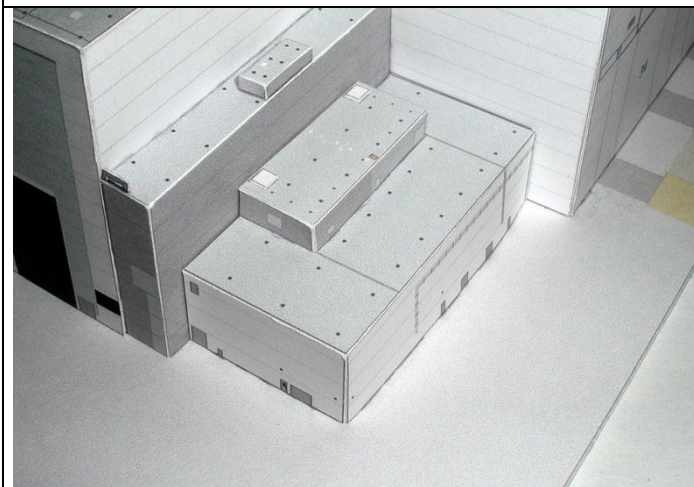




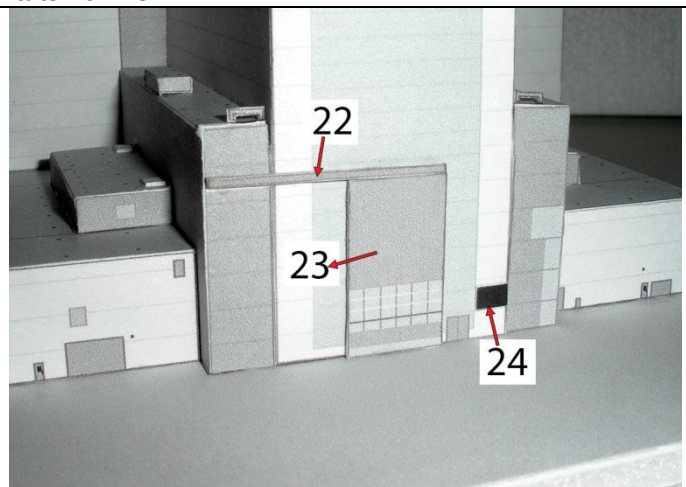
Glue on the black line on 3 and 4.

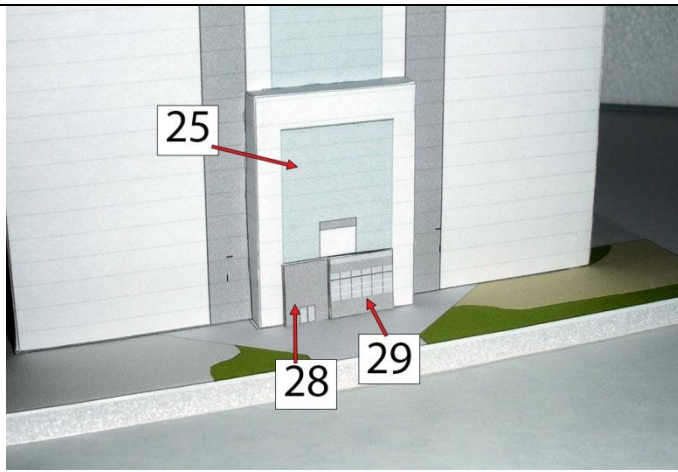

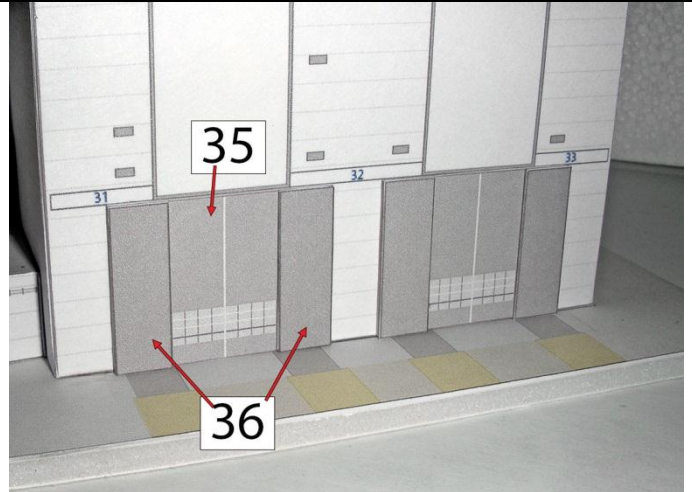
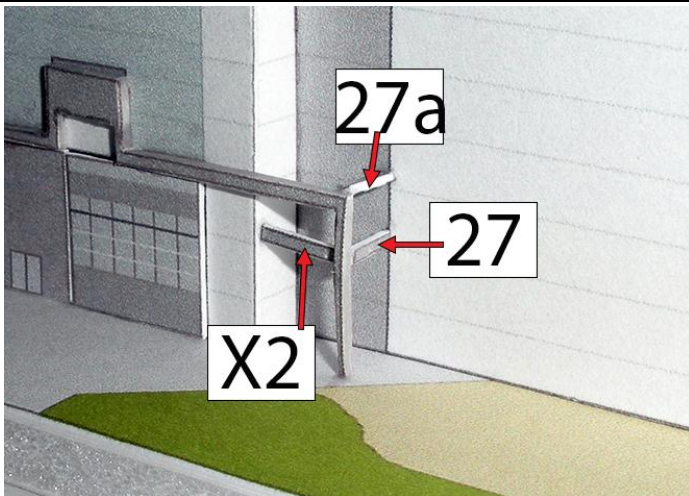




NOTE: 29 was mistakenly glued up-side-down in this example.



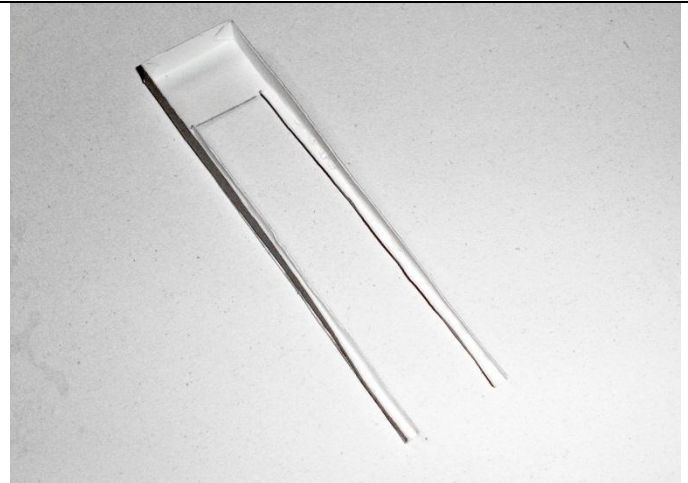
Glue parts X1, X2, 27 and 27a onto the black lines on the building first, then glue 26 on top of 28-29. X1, X2, 27a are glued to backside of the strut on 26. Parts 27 are glued to the backside of X1 and X2.



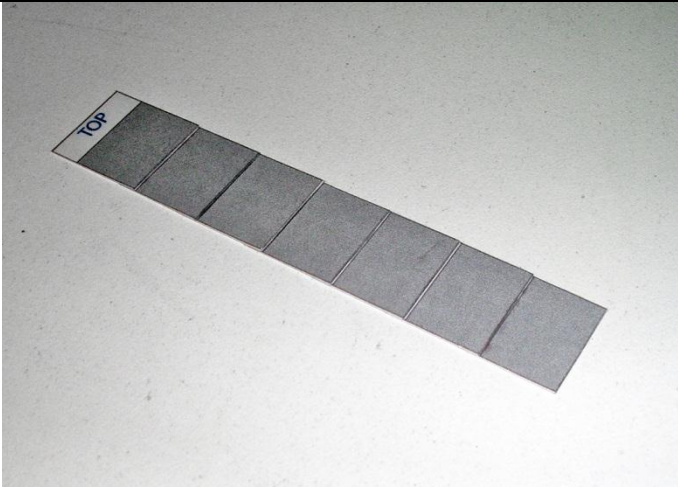
These are 4 sets of these, glue two on both sides of the building as shown.



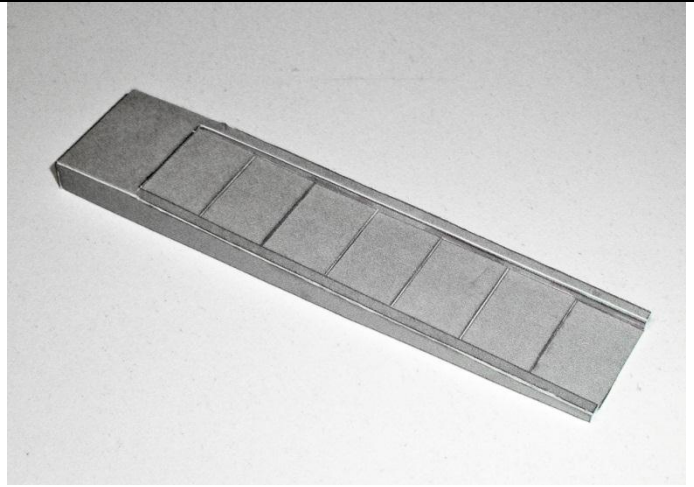
The following is for the detailed version of the High Bay Doors. Score-fold both tabs on each side on parts 30 as shown.



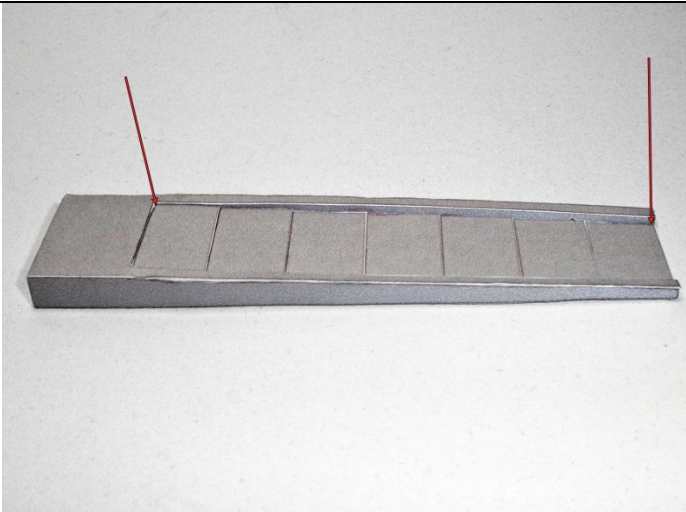
Backside of parts 30



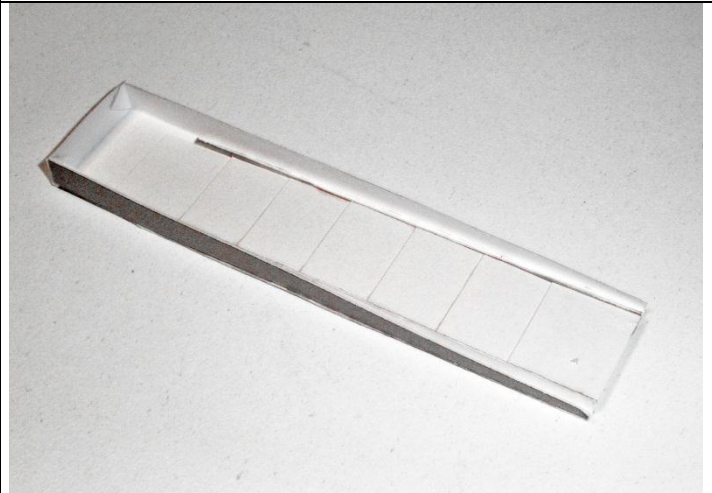
Parts 31 – these are 7 pieces, glue each onto the white glue tab on the other as shown. Must be perfectly straight.



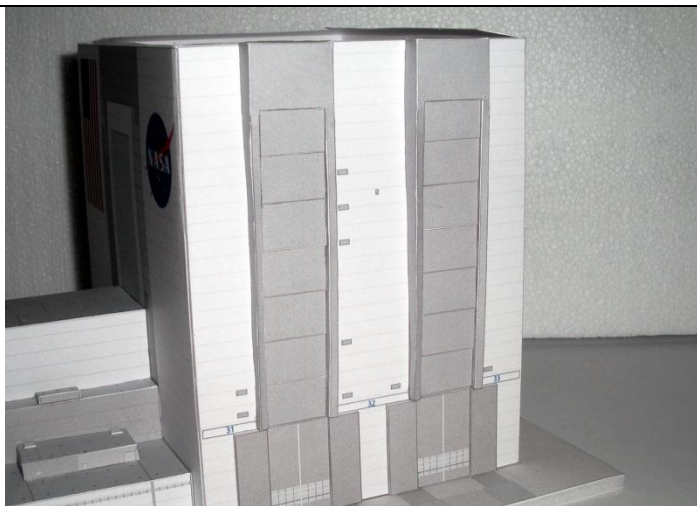
Glue inside between the inner tabs as shown.



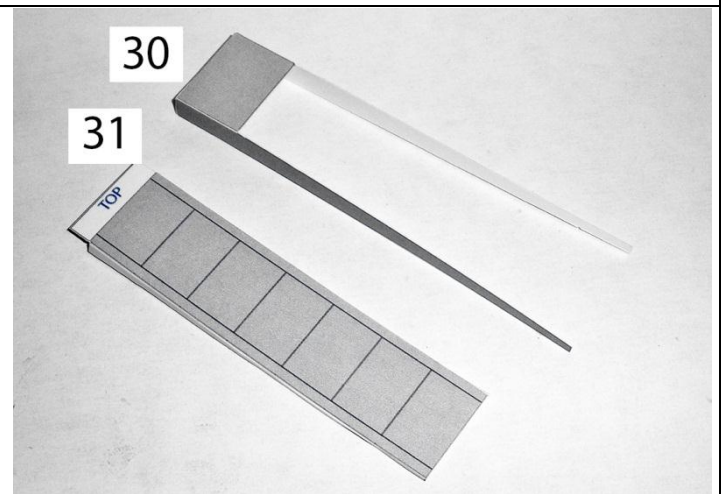
Glue the TOP at the top (1st red arrow), then the bottom onto the bottom inside edge of the inner tab (2nd red arrow). This will match the High Bay Doors on the real building.



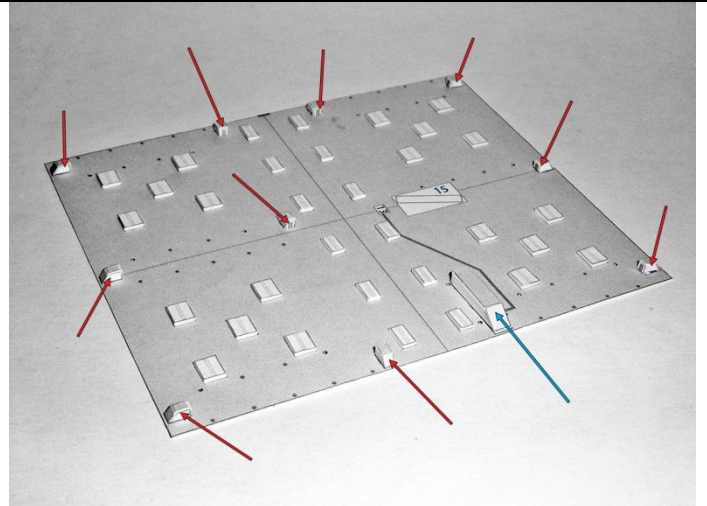
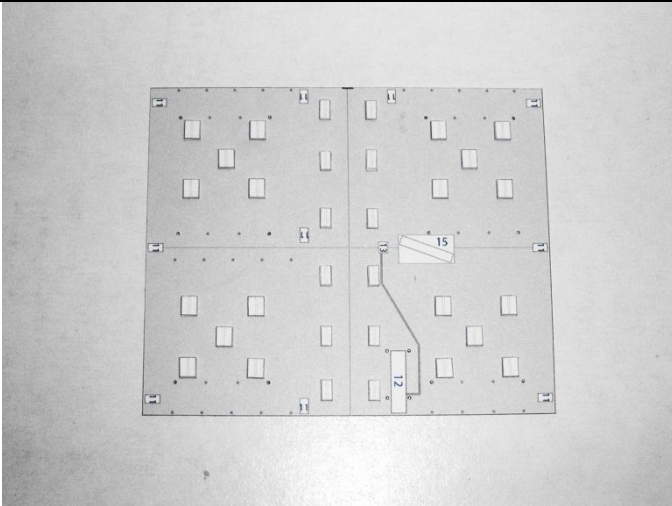
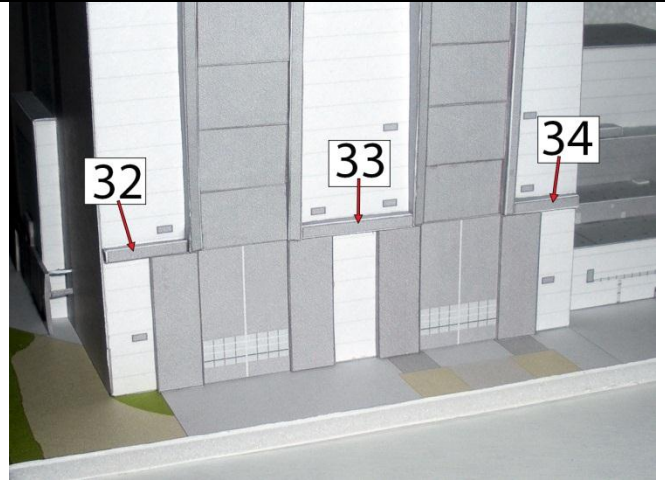
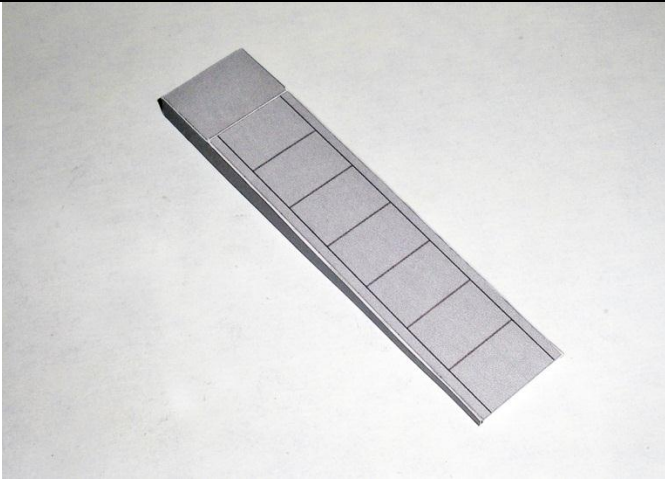
Backside, make four of these.



Glue on both sides of the building as shown.

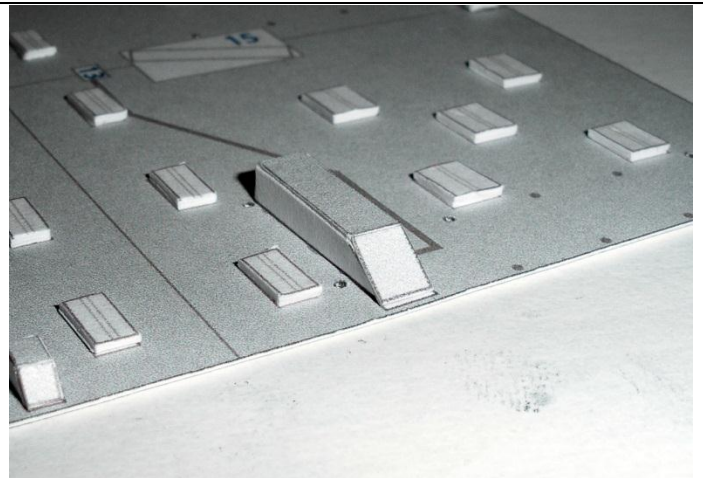
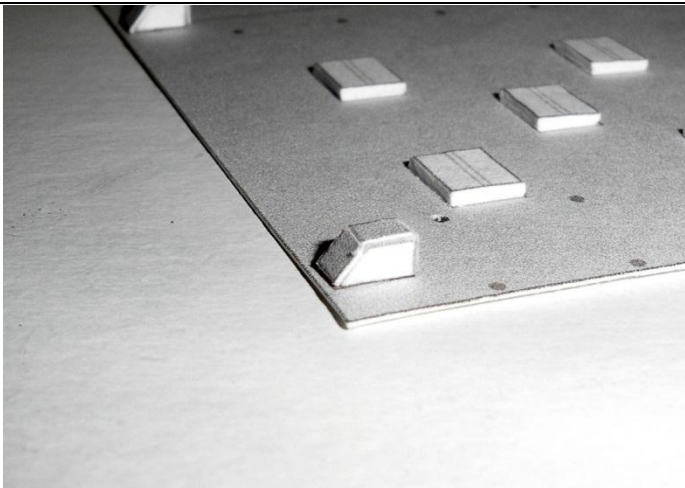


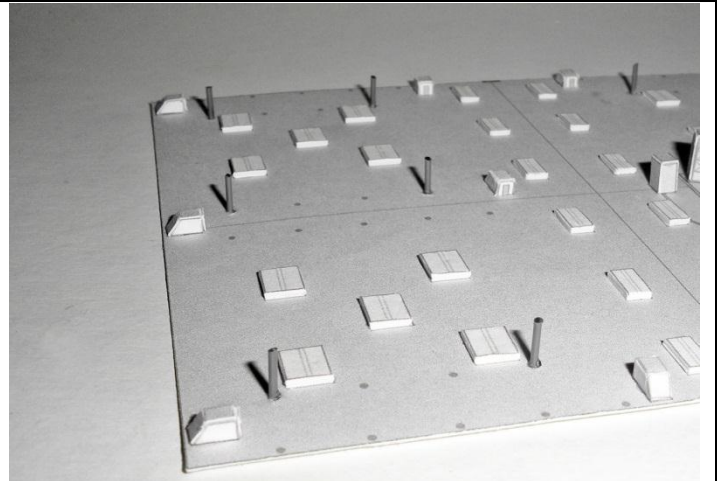
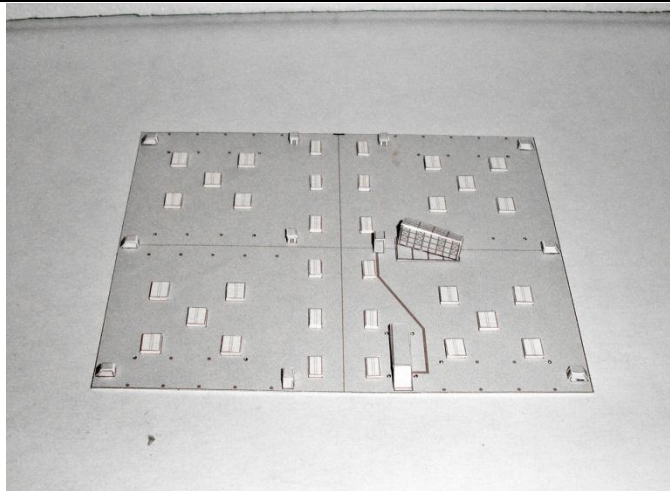
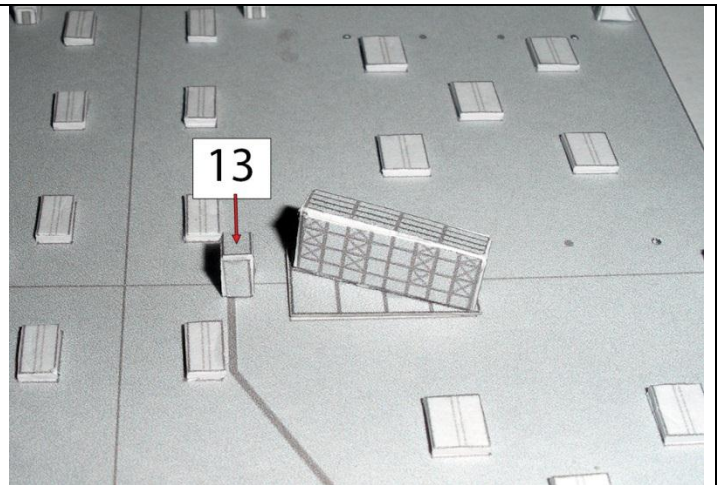
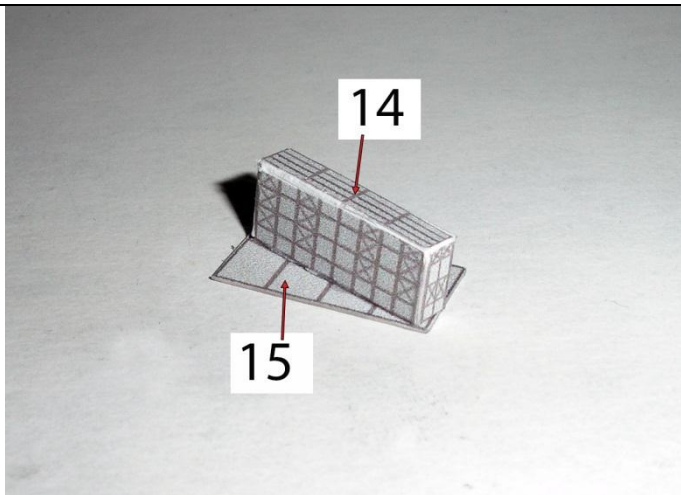
High Bay Doors – Easy Version, can use this instead of the detailed version if you want.



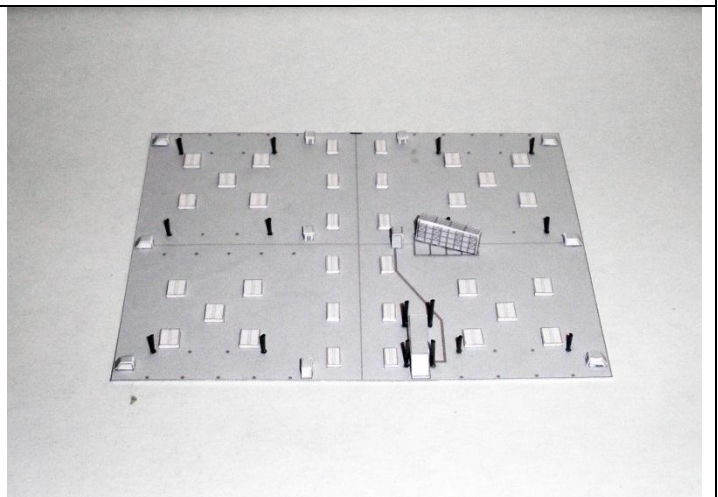
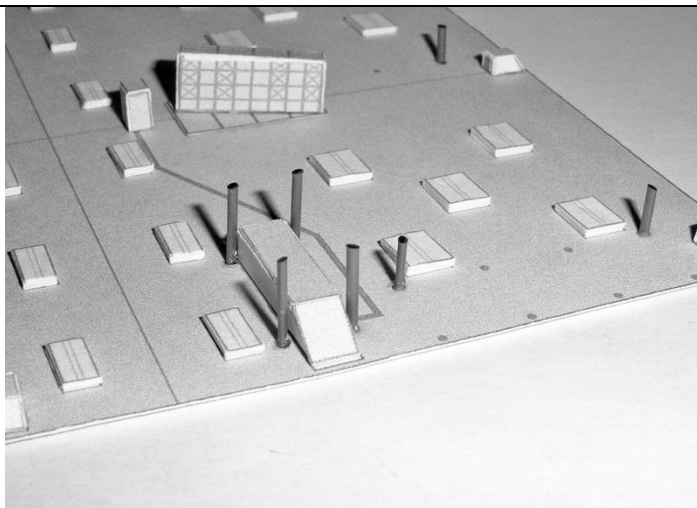
Poke small holes onto the 16 black dots on the top, this will help hold the antennas in place.
Glue parts 9 and 10 onto the matching rectangles on the TOP.

Parts 11 are glued onto the top with the angled end facing outward. Part 12 (blue arrow) is glued onto the labeled area the same way.



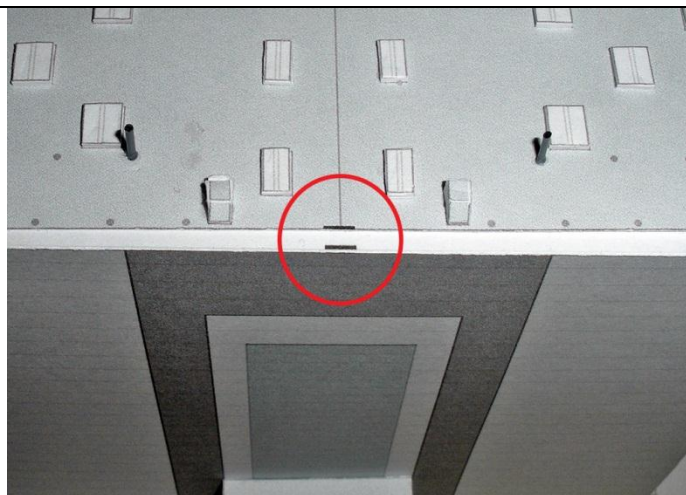


Prepare the 16 antennas according to instructions on page 3 on the page file. Glue the 12 short ones onto the black dots as shown.



Glue the four longer antennas onto the black dots around part 12 as shown.

The TOP should look like this.



Glue on top of the model, match the two black markers for proper parts locations.

Your model is done.
