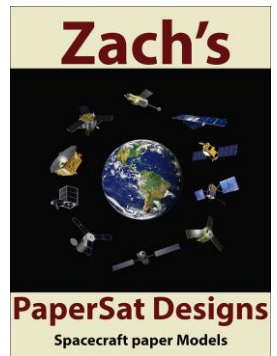


MOAB (Massive Ordnance Air Blast or Mother of All Bombs)
1/32 Scale Paper Model Instructions





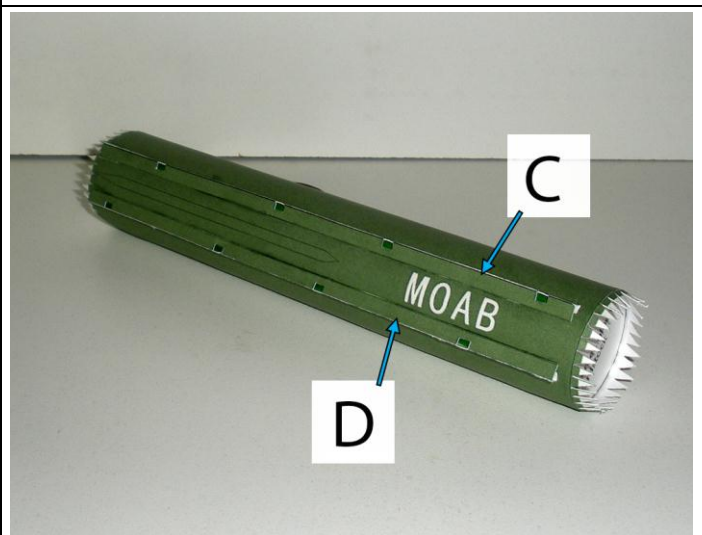
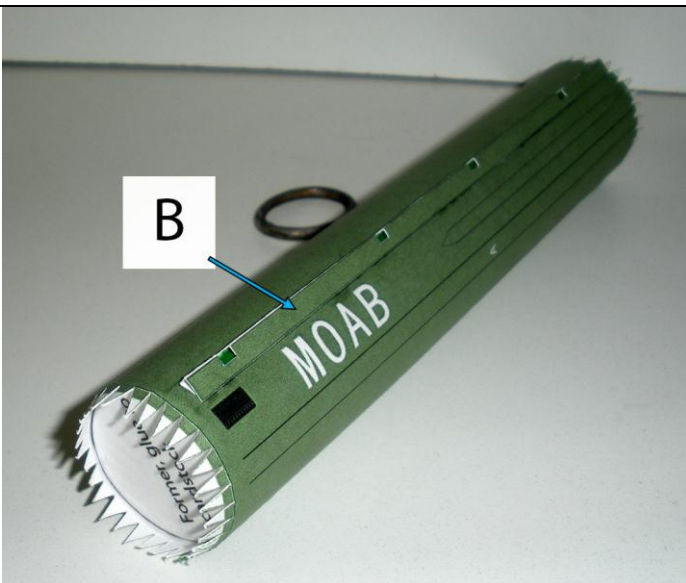
Add some cardstock inside before installing the formers on each end for strength.



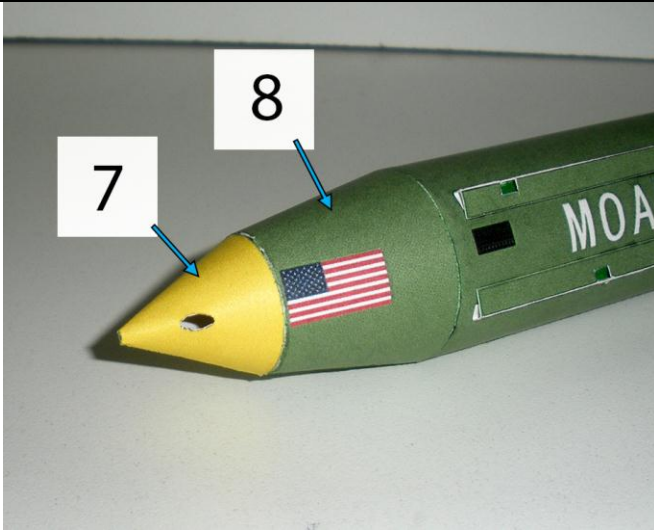
Parts A-D



Glue each to their labels areas as shown.



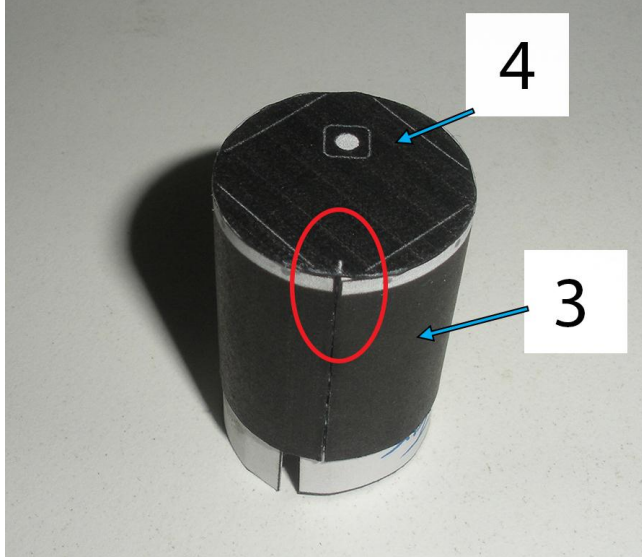
Note how each is glued, top verses the bottom by comparing the cutouts on each. See next photo.



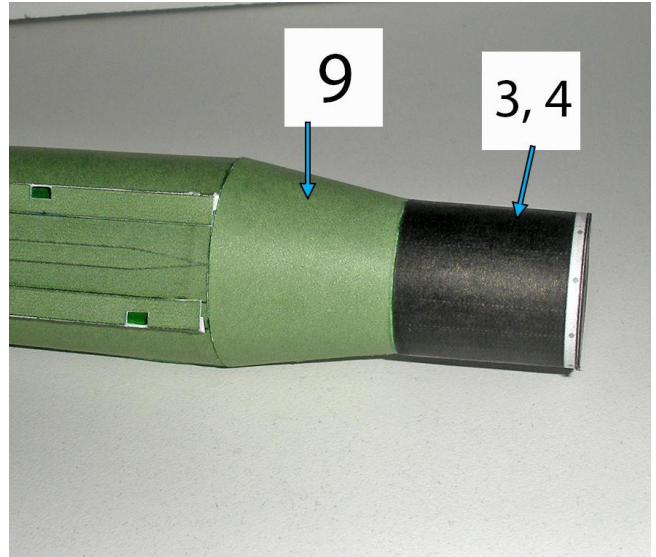
Keep all seems aligned for proper graphic orientation.



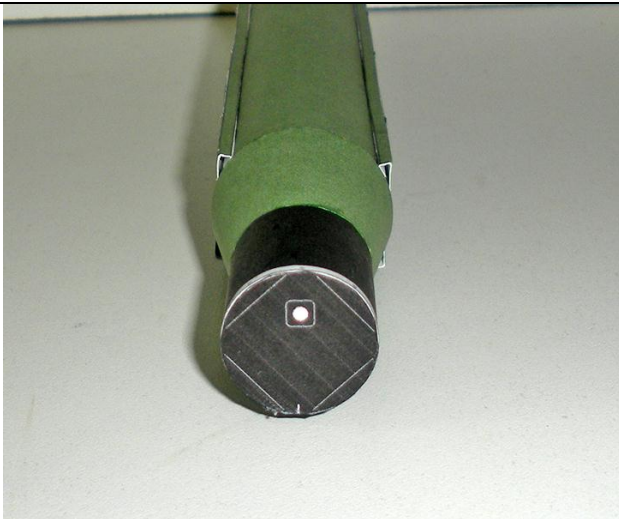
Glue the connector at the opposite end from the end with the silver stripe.



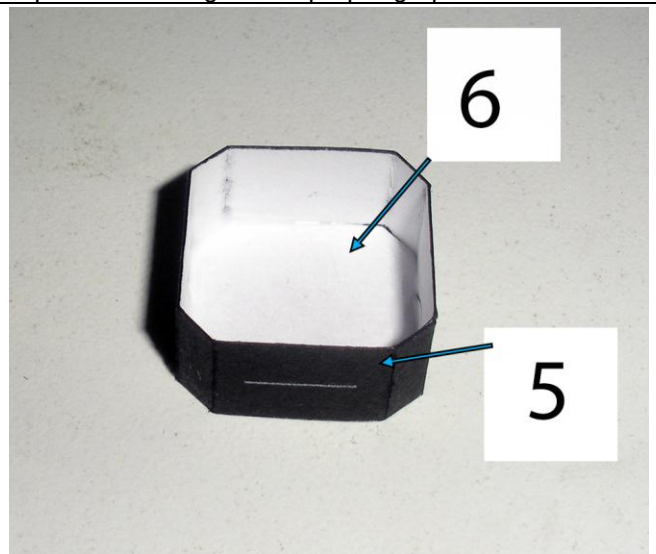
Align the marker on 4 with the seem on 3.



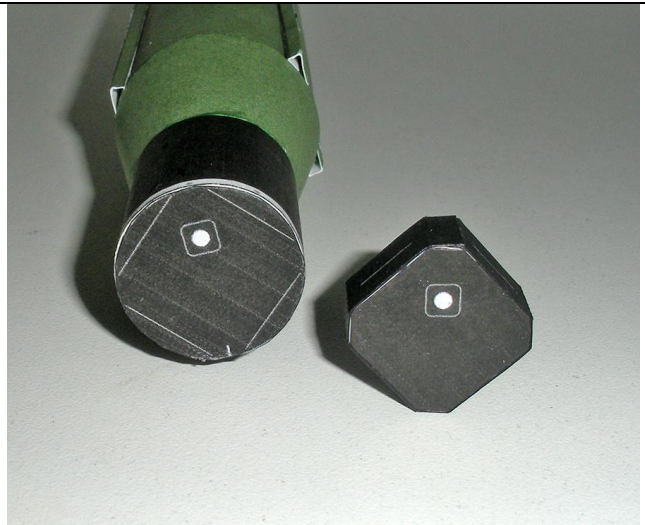
Keep all seems aligned for proper graphic orientation.



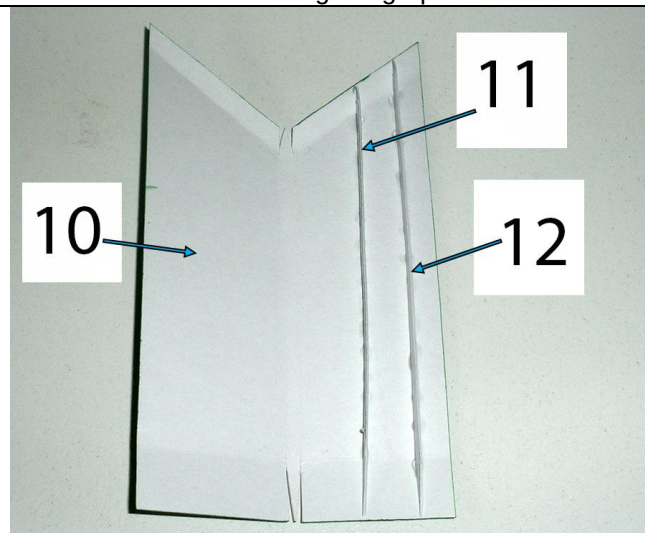
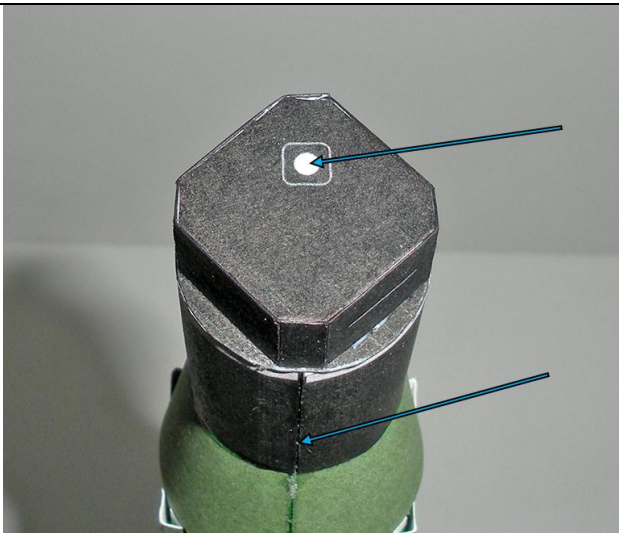
Rear view look.



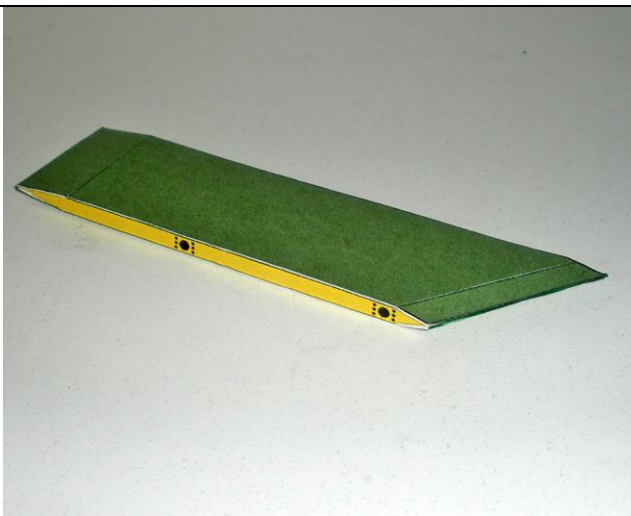
Part 6 fits inside of 5.



Glue this to the back matching the graphics.



11 and 12 are glued inside as shown. These are the internal support struts for the wings.

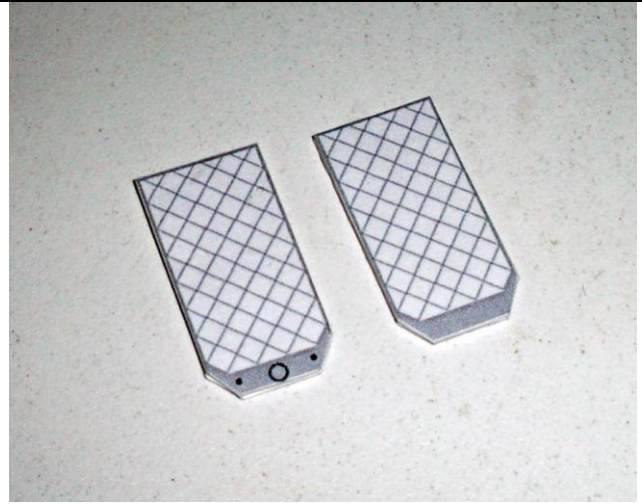


Make 2 of these.

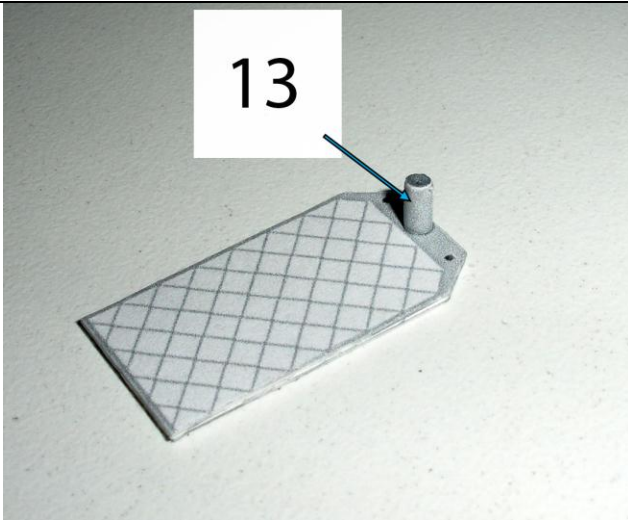
Glue each to the marked areas on the body as shown.



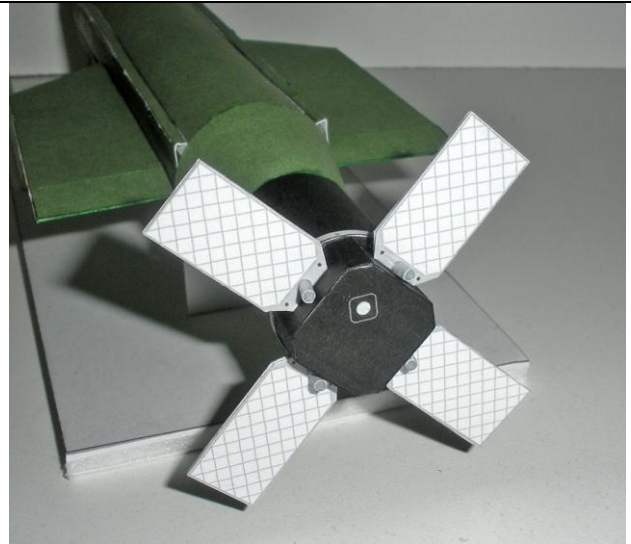
View from the top.



Grid Fins...
Glue each to cardstock, then each pair back-to-back.
Make 4.



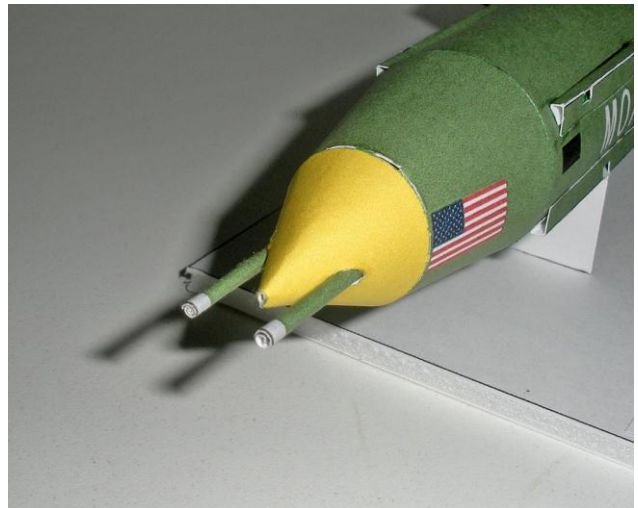
Glue to the circle on each fin.



Glue each fin to the line (part 5) at the back end as shown.



Part 15, roll each to a tight, solid rod.



Insert and glue into the holes on the nose cone as shown.

Your model is done.
