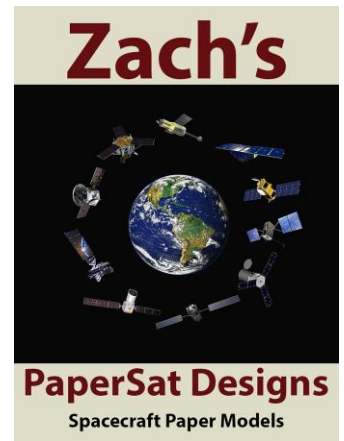


Sea Dragon
1/380 Scale Paper Model Instructions



NOTE: align all seams together for best results.



Top half...

Roll part 1 into a tube.



Roll some extra cardstock and insert inside the tube, make sure there is around 1 inch space between the top and bottom edge of the tube and the extra cardstock. This will make the body more robust.



Cut out the three formers from page 3 on the parts file and glue one against the extra cardstock near the top edge of the body (under the spike glue tabs).



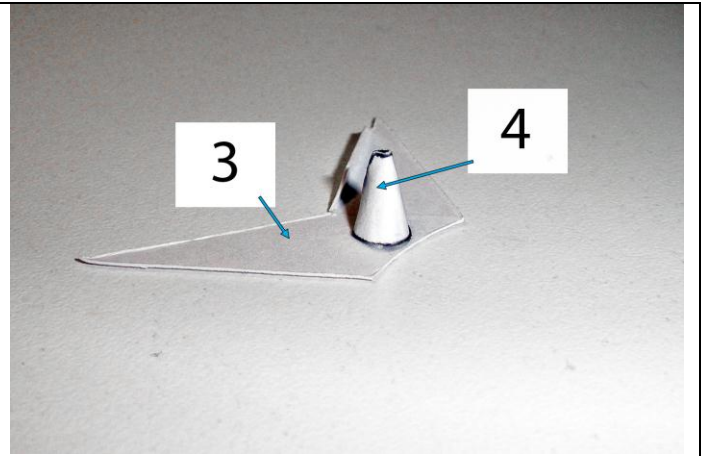
Glue the other former against the extra cardstock around 1 inch from the bottom of the body. This will leave room to glue the 1 to 2 connector in place.



Glue the 1 to 2 connector up to the line into the bottom edge of the body.
Set this to the side for now.



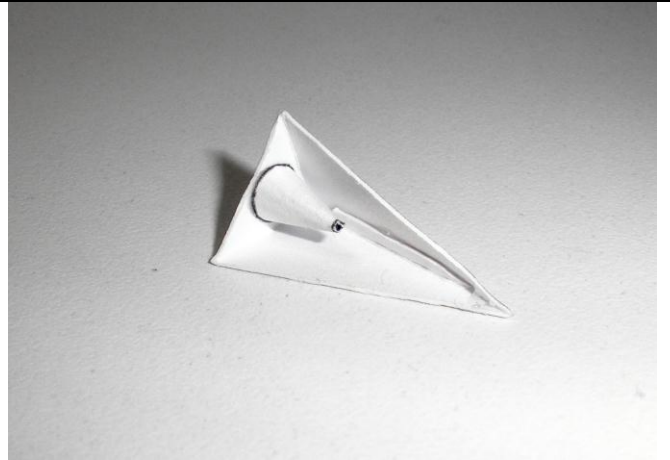
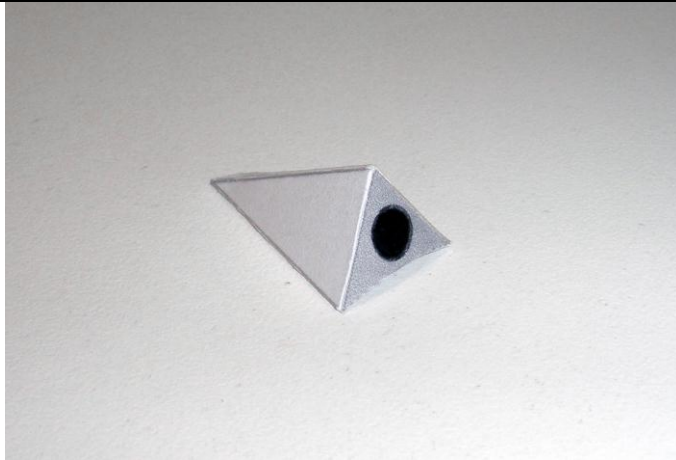
Part 2 (bottom half) - Add cardstock inside the same way you did on part 1.



Glue the third former inside against the extra cardstock near the Bottom edge (under the spiked glue tabs).

Cut out the blue circles from part 3.

Set this to the side for now.

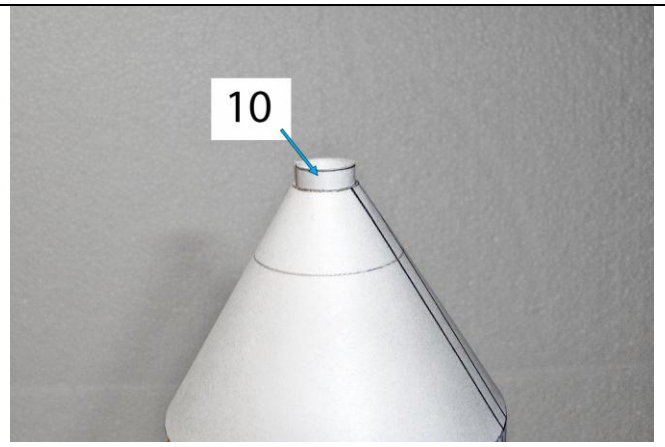
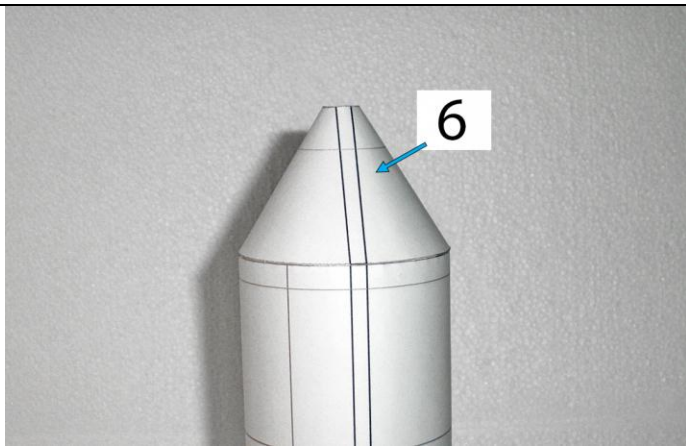


Fold-glue together – make four of these.

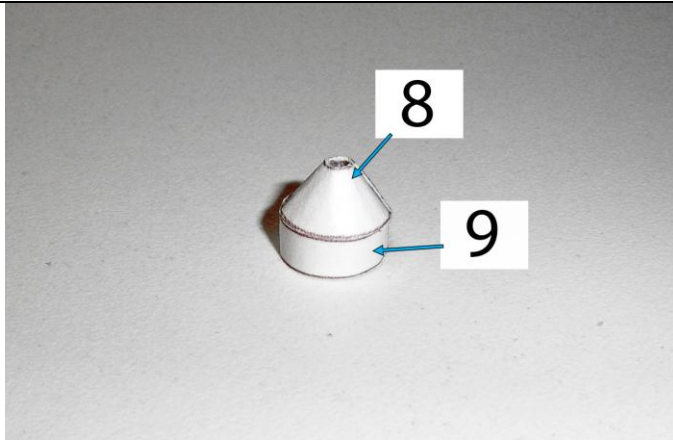


Glue each onto a horizontal line on the body as shown.

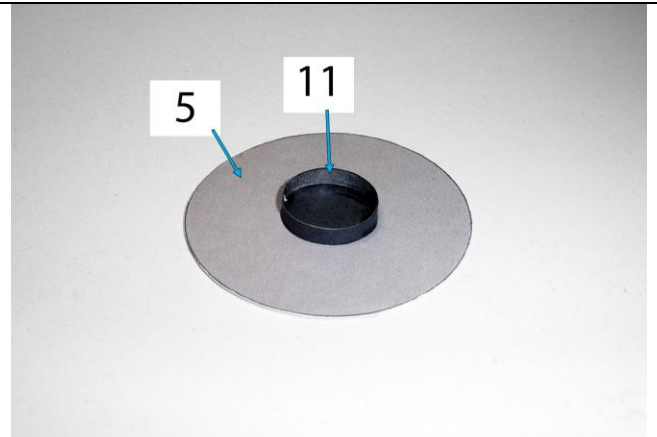
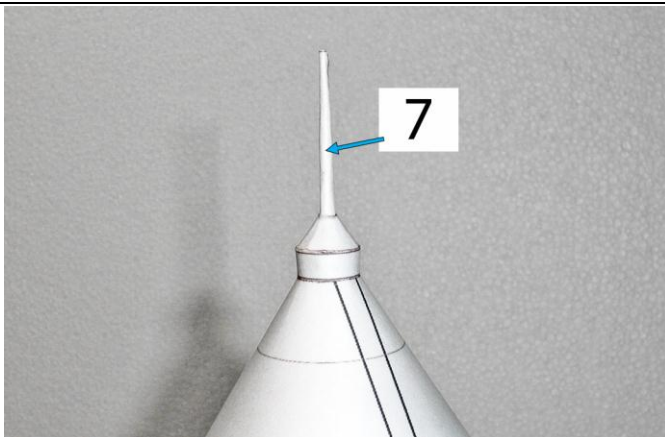


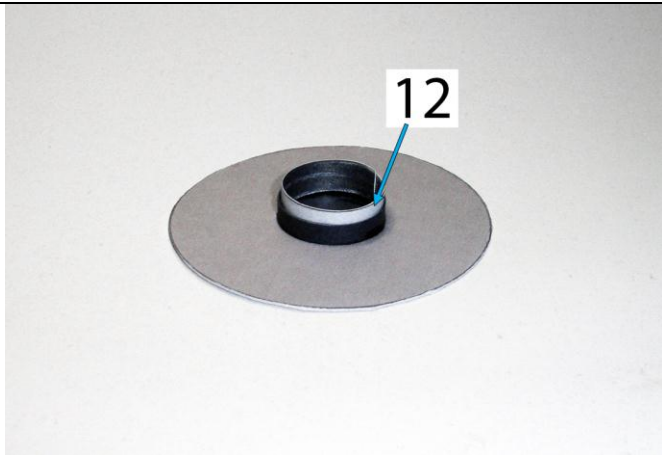


Glue the connector (part 10) inside the opening as shown.

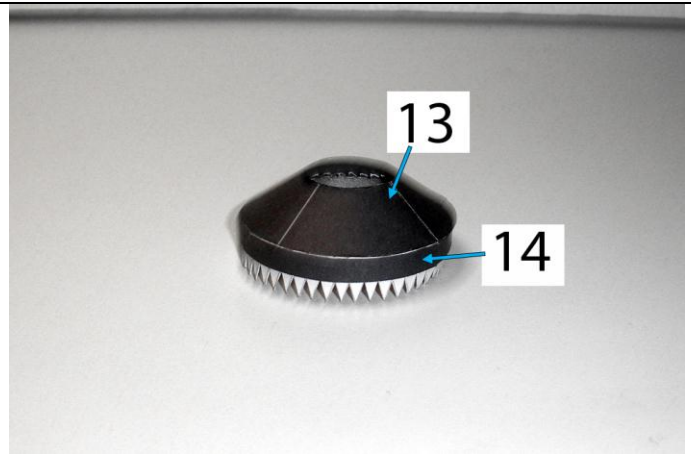


Glue over the connector into the top.

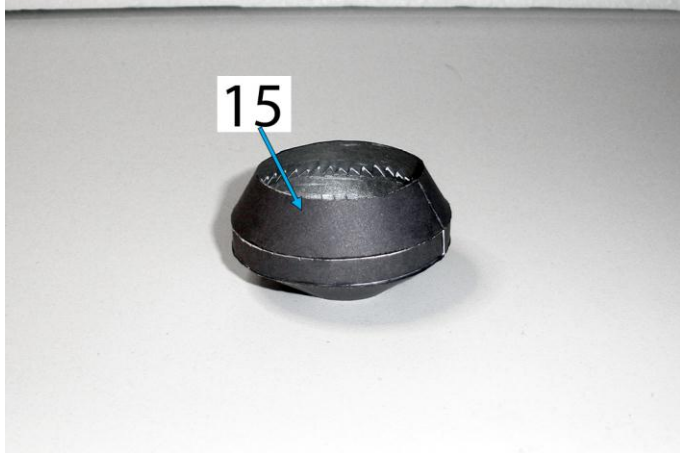




Glue the connector (part 12) inside part 11 as shown.



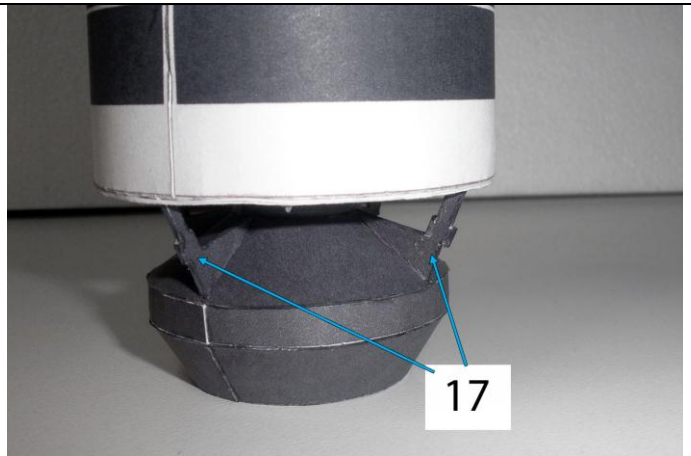
Keep all seems aligned for parts 13 – 15.



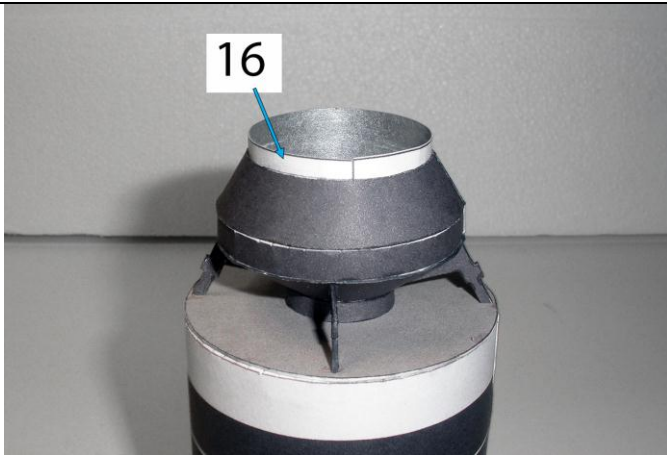
Glue over the connector onto the bottom as shown.



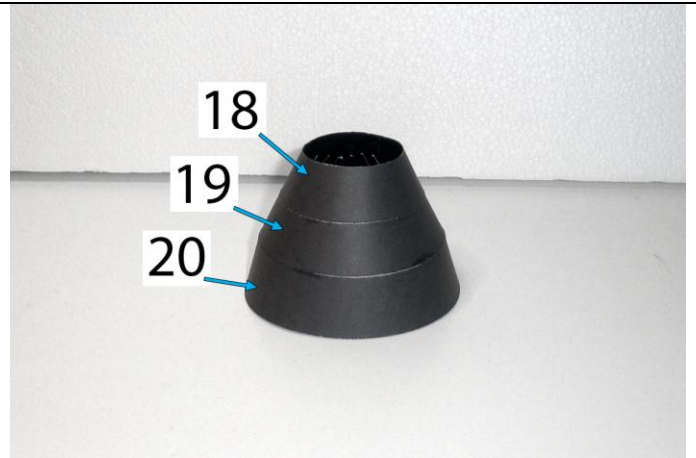
Glue to bottom of part 2, match seems on parts 13 – 15 with seem on part 2.



Glue on the seem and the grey lines as shown.



Glue connector (part 16) up to the grey line inside as shown.



Glue over the connector onto the base as shown, match all seems.



Glue the top and bottom halves together while matching the seems on parts 1 and 2 together.

Your model is done.
